

We're excited to announce this very important event that is the result of a close collaboration between the Jewish Coalition of Berkeley and the American Jewish Committee (AJC Northern CA).

Amidst the rising tide of anti-Jewish hate across the country, we will be joined by the new **Alameda County District Attorney, Ursula Jones Dickson**, as well as representatives of the **Berkeley Police Department** to for a community discussion on public safety for the Berkeley Jewish community.
